Alert Level 2

Our tamariki and whanau are complying really well with the health and safety requirements.

As a reminder with the return of Covid Alert Level 2, the following practices have been put in place for our tamariki and whanau:

- regular cleaning in classrooms

- person/teacher opening the door
- no hugging, kissing or sharing of food or drinks
- 1 metre physical distancing around school at all times.

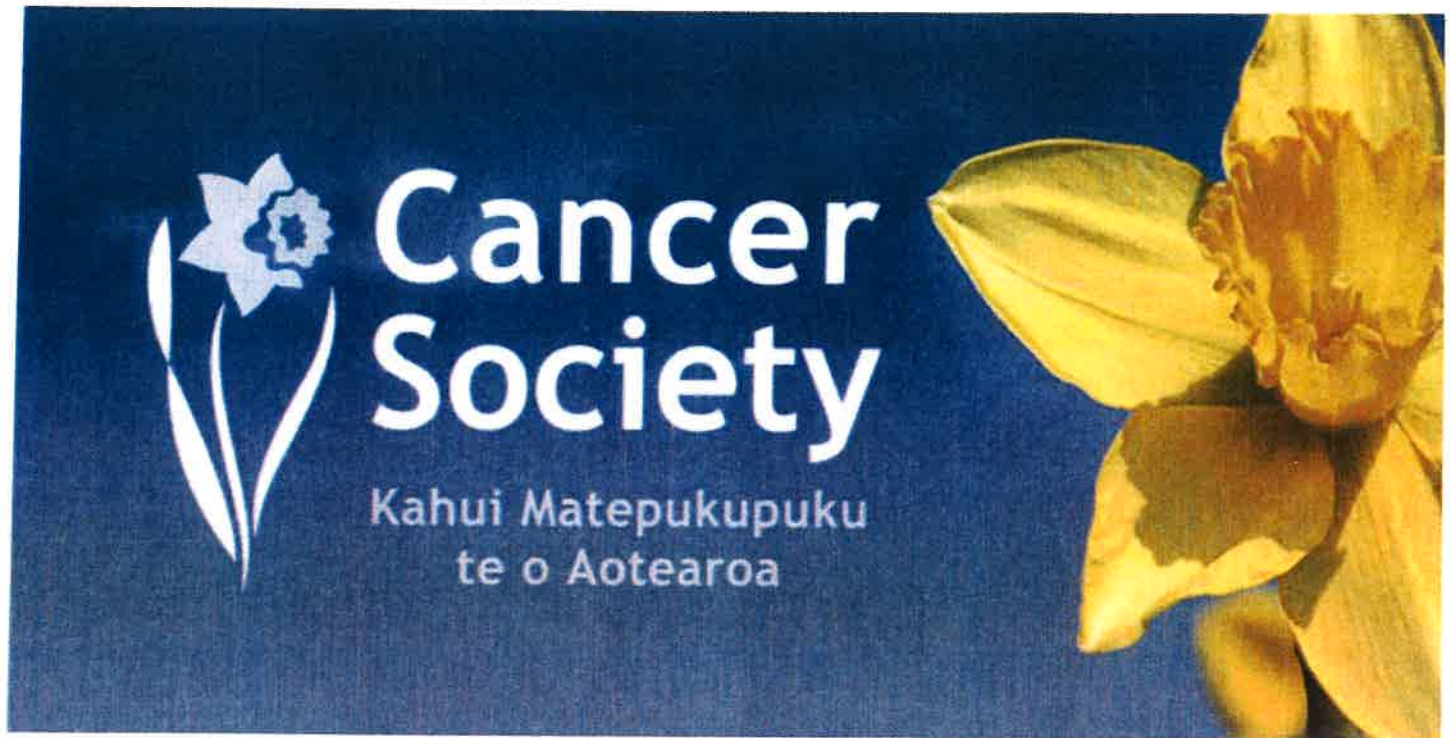
