As you are all aware we are currently at Alert Level 2. This will remain in place until at least 11:59pm on Monday 21 September.

This Alert Level will next be reviewed on Monday 21 September. The Government has agreed, in principle, to move New Zealand down to Alert Level 1.

If the Government announces a return to Level 1 on Monday, our school will return at alert level 1 by 8.00am on Tuesday morning.

Please remember that the 8.30am start will continue through to the end of the year, regardless of Alert Levels.
