Welcome to Term 3

Another very busy term has started. A strong emphasis will be on attendance again this term.

While we have some tamariki who are attending very regularly, missing less than 5 days all term, we also have a concerning number of children who are missing 2 or 3 days every week.

This type of absence means there is no consistent learning for these children and it is difficult for them to make the expected progress for their age.

A number of families had some genuine and serious illnesses that affected their tamariki's attendance. They kept in contact with the school and we were not concerned about these tamariki's attendance.

Tamariki we are concerned about may be referred to the Attendance officer, Mitchell Tiaiti, Oranga Tamariki, the police or can be prosecuted by the school.

Swimming

Swimming starts next week for our middle and senior school tamariki.

Because drowning is one of the highest causes of death in New Zealand it is important that our tamariki can swim.
